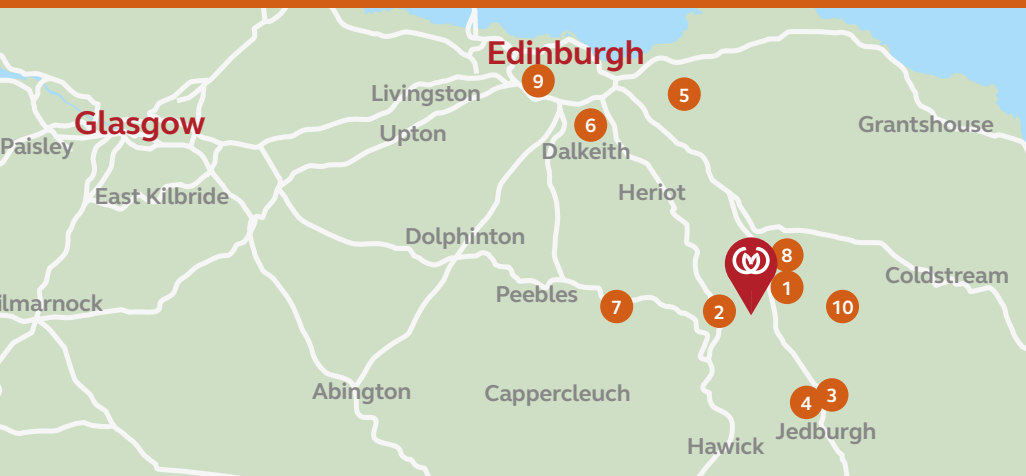

Things to do

1 Harmony Garden

A tranquil walled garden showcasing manicured lawns and vibrant borders around a Georgian Manor with views of the Melrose Abbey ruins.

2 Abbotsford House

A Country House on the south bank of the River Tweed. Built by poet Sir Walter Scott in 1817 – a magnificent example of Scottish Baronial style.

3 Mary Queen of Scots' Visitor Centre

In a pear-tree garden, this 16th Century Tower House where Mary stayed in 1566, explores her tragic life through paintings and objects.

4 Jedburgh Castle Jail

Built in the 1820s on the site of the Jedburgh Castle, this restored model prison offers a fascinating insight into jail life in Scotland.

5 Glenkinchie Distillery

A single malt Scotch whisky distillery, named 'The Edinburgh Malt'. Celebrated for its light, floral flavour and as one of the Johnnie Walker distilleries.

6 Go Ape – Dalkeith

An outdoor adventure playground with high-ropes courses, ziplines, Tarzan Swings and forest activities in the woodland treetops.

7 Ridelines

An award-winning mountain bike tuition company offering skills coaching, guided rides, instructor qualifications and kids camps.

8 Melrose

A picturesque town along the River Tweed beneath the peaks of the Eildon Hills. Known for abbey ruins, walking trails, small-town hospitality and the home of Rugby Sevens.

9 Edinburgh

The historic capital of Scotland. One of Europe's most beautiful cities, famous for its distinct architectural split: the labyrinthine Old Town and the elegant, Georgian New Town.

10 Kelso

A beautiful market town where the rivers Tweed and Teviot meet. Renowned for its French-style cobbled square, elegant Georgian architecture and salmon fishing.

Walk

Enjoy various local walks, including along the River Tweed, the Melrose Paths, the Borders Abbey Way and the Southern Upland Way.

Join part of the 62 mile route through the borders of St. Cuthbert's Way.

Cycle

The town of Innerleithen is a world-renowned championship mountain biking course. Waymarked routes offer a great range of riding from steep, tree-lined routes to fast, open trails.

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 1, Dover to Shetland.

Borders Book Festival is held annually in June in Melrose. This literary festival takes place in the National Trust Harmony Garden.

Other nearby attractions worth a visit include: Melrose Abbey, the Trimontium Museum, Eildon Hills, Priorwood Garden and the impressive Victorian railway bridge Leaderfoot Viaduct (also known as the Drygrange Viaduct).
