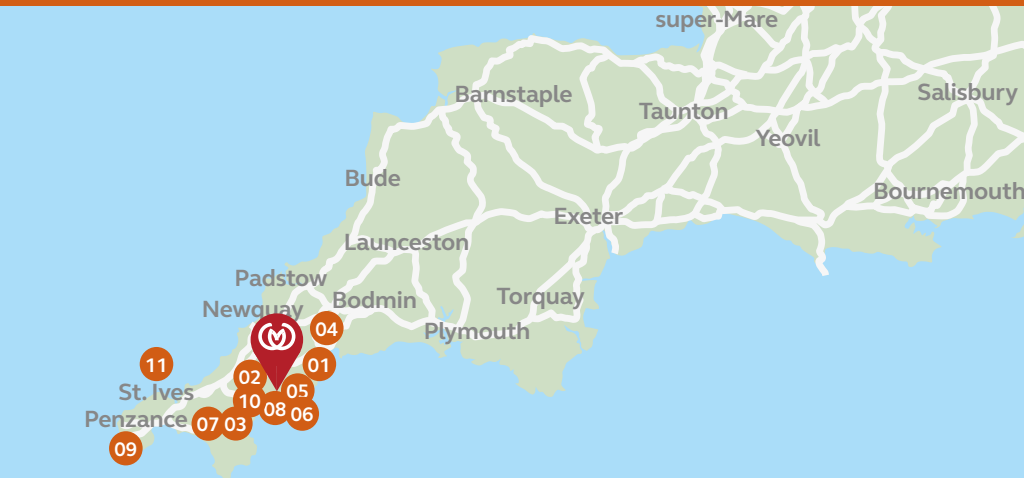

Things to do

- 1 Mevagissey**
In a National Landscape this traditional Cornish fishing village is renowned for its quaint, narrow streets, bustling twin harbour, working fishing fleet and smuggling past.
- 2 Treliassick House and Garden**
A coastal estate on a peninsula overlooking the River Fal. Featuring a country house, an elevated garden with exotic plants and subtropical flora and woodland walks.
- 3 National Seal Sanctuary**
A marine rescue centre rehabilitating injured or orphaned grey seals and providing homes for seals, sea lions and penguins. Offering public viewing and a seal hospital.
- 4 The Eden Project**
Featuring massive Biomes that house the world's largest indoor rainforest it operates as a 'living theatre' of plants, promoting sustainability, environmental education and regeneration.

- 5 Watersports**
Make the most of Cornwall's amazing beaches and rivers with sailing, surfing, kite surfing, kayaking and boat trips.
- 6 Sea Fishing**
Diverse, quality and lively angling, ranging from productive rocky shores for bass, mackerel and pollock to boat fishing for shark and reef species.
- 7 The Roseland Peninsula**
A tranquil, unspoilt National Landscape known for dramatic coastal cliffs, sheltered sandy beaches and wooded creeks. Often described as a hidden enclave.
- 8 St Ives**
A beautiful seaside town adorned by golden beaches, pretty cobbled streets, luscious flora and a thriving art scene.

Walk

Enjoy walking along the coastal footpaths and beaches. From site, follow the path to St Anthony Head.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 3: Bristol to Lands End.
