Things to do

- 1 Dartmoor National Park**
One of the last great wildernesses in the UK, known for its expansive, untamed moorland, deep river valleys, ancient woodlands and iconic wild ponies.
- 2 Saltram House and Gardens**
A magnificent Grade I listed Georgian Mansion set in 20 acre gardens and extensive riverside parkland.
- 3 National Marine Aquarium**
The UK's largest public aquarium, hosting over 4,000 marine animals and ground-breaking ocean conservation work.
- 4 Babbacombe Model Village**
A park featuring over 400 miniature scenes, 13,000 residents and models portraying British life. Renowned for gardens, humorous scenes and detailed landmarks.
- 5 Woodlands Family Theme Park**
Devon's largest family theme park, offering a 100 acre mix of indoor and outdoor attractions, featuring water-coasters, big family rides, a zoo-farm and a falconry centre.
- 6 Adventure Bay**
Outdoor experiences, including coasteering, sea kayaking, paddleboarding and climbing in guided family and bigger groups.
- 7 Sea Kayak Devon**
Guided sea kayak coastal tours, hidden caves and beaches, courses and overnight expeditions catering to all skill levels.
- 8 Plymouth**
Known as Britain's Ocean City and renowned for its deep maritime, naval and exploration history, today it is a vibrant, modern city with a major port and scenic waterfront.
- 9 Dartmouth**
One of South Devon's most popular and charming towns with narrow streets, medieval buildings, a bustling harbour and yachting centre.
- 10 Torquay**
Part of the UNESCO-listed English Riviera, due to its mild climate, sandy beaches, palm trees and vibrant harbour.

Walk

The southern tip of Dartmoor is optimum trekking country – the ground is relatively level and exposed making it suitable for different levels of ability. Climb the Western Beacon and you'll feel on top of the world!

Cycle

Follow the Plym Valley cycle trail through woodland and countryside. The route starts from Marsh Mills roundabout near Plymouth and is suitable for all the family.

The nearest National Cycle Network Route is 28: Okehampton to Plymouth.

You could also follow Route 2 that runs from Dover to St Austell.
