Things to do

1 Gloucestershire Warwickshire Steam Railway

A spectacular 14 mile heritage railway through the Cotswolds, offering a nostalgic journey with stunning views of the Malvern Hills and Vale of Evesham.

2 Batsford Arboretum

60 acre tree-filled sanctuary of diverse trees, wild flowers and Japanese inspired design. One of the largest private tree collections in the UK.

3 Cotswolds Falconry Centre

Eagles, hawks, owls, vultures and falcons give daily flying demonstrations, educating with speed, grace and agility.

4 Shakespeare Tour

A walking tour tracing the great playwright's life – these guided excursions combine history, theatrical performances and iconic sites.

5 Cotswold Archery

A dedicated outdoor archery range providing expert-led archery and medieval longbow experiences for all abilities and ages 8+.

6 Stratford-upon-Avon Butterfly Farm

The UK's largest tropical butterfly paradise, inviting visitors to walk through a indoor rainforest filled with hundreds of free-flying exotic butterflies.

7 British Motor Museum

The world's largest collection and display of over 400 historic British cars. Exploring the rich heritage of British automotive design, engineering and manufacturing.

8 Cotswold Farm Park

Interact closely and meet over 50 rare and native breeds including the Golden Guernsey goats and Highland cattle, with seasonal demonstrations and children's activities.

9 Stow-on-the-Wold

A historic hilltop market town nearly 800 feet above sea level. Famous for its natural honey-coloured stone architecture, antique shops and deep English Civil War history.

Walk

With miles of rural walks to enjoy, the Cotswolds Way National Trail is one of the most popular and runs from Chipping Norton to Bath.

The Diamond route winds through attractive Cotswolds villages.

Cycle

The nearest National Cycle Network route is 48: Leicester to Bath.

- ✓ Barrier fob issued on arrival

- ✓ Code operated door locks issued on arrival

Connectivity

- ✓ Mobile phone signal – good. Mobile phone signal may vary depending on network provider
- ✓ TV reception – poor. TV booster system is available on bollard. (25 metre aerial coaxial cable required)
- ✓ Club Wi-Fi. Premium wifi – *charges apply*. Free wifi to the pitch

Emergency out of hours information can be found on the reception door/window and in the information room.

- ✓ Washing machines are operated by contactless debit or credit card. All washing machine cycles are £5 and a pre-wash is £1.25
- ✓ Dryers are token operated only. Tokens are available from reception at £1.25 each. A 15 minute tumble dryer cycle is £1.25
