Good walking routes near the site are Kings Way, Three Castles Path and Itchen Way. Bramdean Common and Farley Mount Country Park are a short drive away and both are good walking areas.

Visitor's top tips

If you enjoy National Trust properties, Hinton Ampner, Uppark, Petworth House, The Vyne, Mottisfont and Mompresson House are all within an hours drive.

There is so much to see in Historic Winchester, make sure you spend a couple of days exploring.

You can use the Park and Ride, or catch the bus from 5 minutes walk away and you'll be in Winchester in 8 minutes.

The Royal Green Jackets Museum and Waterloo Exhibition in Winchester is an excellent day out.

There are some lovely dog walks on and around site to explore.

We loved the Winchester Farmers Market, held on the second and last Sunday every month – it's the largest in the UK!

Southampton and Portsmouth are fantastic for shopping, and if you're looking for some great discounts on designer brands, head to Gunwharf Quays.

The Winchester Science Centre and Planetarium is a lovely, interesting day out with something for all ages to enjoy.
