### At a Glance



#### Level Access

- The site is set relatively level throughout



#### Step only Access

- Male and Female facilities
- Dishwashing facilities



#### Accessible Toilets and Showers

- There is a combined accessible toilet and shower cubicle in the toilet block



#### Accessible Pitches

- No designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.

## Arrival and Reception

### Approach Route

- Access onto the site is via a tarmac driveway
- The reception building is on the left hand side when you enter the site
- The gate from the road is left open during the day but is closed at night
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

### Parking

- A new arrival bay is set within a few metres of the Reception building.
- There is a small visitor car park with space for 6 vehicles, near reception however there are no designated disabled bays
- There is one late night arrival bay

### Entrance into Reception

- There is a paved area surrounding the reception which is level to the roadway
- The Entrance door is 800mm wide, over a 30mm threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens inwards
- A call bell is available to summon assistance, this is 1500mm above ground level



## Reception

- There is approximately 1550mm x 1650mm turning space, clear of the desk and furniture
- The reception desk is set 900mm above the floor with no dropped section
- There are some items available for sale between 70mm and 1800mm high
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop



## Getting around the Site

- The site is generally set relatively level throughout
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac

## Pitches

- There are 77 pitches on site, all of which are hardstanding
- Roll out mats are not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- There are 6 hardstanding pitches which are approximately 10 to 50 metres from the toilet block and 40 metres from the reception

## Camping Pitches

- There are 12 camping pitches, these are to the south of the site behind reception
- There is parking available opposite the pitches

- Both electric and non-electric pitches are available
- There are picnic tables available for use here



## Toilets and Changing Facilities

### Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Toilet Block

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is located close to the entrance of the site
- The accessible facilities are accessed via a dropped kerb to the paved area and then a short ramp with a single handrail.
- The door is 900mm wide, over a level threshold, and opens outwards
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 2100mm x 3900mm
- The WC pan is left hand transfer.
- The shower seat is left hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 450mm, and the shower seat is 450mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 1200mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are 1300mm high



- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1400mm above floor level
- There is also a baby bath in a 950mm high counter
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with lever



## Standard Toilets and Washrooms

- There is one toilet and shower block which is close to the entrance of the site
- There is space for one vehicle to park next to the toilet block
- Entrance doors are accessed by a paved area, which is accessed via dropped kerbs
- The entrance doors to the male and female facilities are 750mm wide, the female door has a 170mm step and the male door has an 80mm step
- The female area has 8 WC cubicles, 4 Shower cubicles and 6 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- The male area has 5 WC cubicles, 4 Urinals, 4 Shower cubicles and 6 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- There is a modified WC, Shower and Privacy Washbasin cubicle in each area, with grab rails to assist with mobility
- Taps in each area incorporate lever controls

## Other Facilities

### Dishwashing – Toilet Block

- The dishwashing area is accessed through the same external door to the male facilities, and there is a further 120mm high step to the dishwashing area
- There are 4 sinks at 900mm high with no kneespace underneath
- There is 1800mm x 3950mm clear space behind the sinks
- Twist turn taps available

### Dishwashing - Facilities Block

- There is a dishwashing area to the side of the facilities block which is to the north of the site
- The dishwashing area is external, with a 1100mm wide opening and a 50mm step to access
- There is 3900mm x 700mm clear space behind the sinks
- There are 4 sinks at 870mm high with no knee space beneath
- There are twist turn taps available



### Laundry – Facilities Block

- The laundry room is in the facilities block, which is to the north of the site

- The laundry room is accessed via a 900mm wide ramp or via 3 140mm high steps, which lead to a level landing
- There is an 850mm wide door, with a 20mm threshold, which opens inwards
- There is 1400mm x 2850mm manoeuvring space
- There are two front loading washing machines and one front loading tumble dryer
- There are 2 sinks at 900mm high with 800mm knee space below
- Twist turn taps fitted



### Drying Room - Facilities Block

- There is a drying room in the facilities block
- The door is 850mm wide over a level threshold
- There is 2600mm x 2100mm manoeuvring space within the room
- There is a drying rack at 1600mm high and one at 2000mm high
- There is also a low bench around the room at 500mm high





## Games Room - Facilities Block

- There is a games room within the facilities block
- The door opens to 850mm wide, over a level threshold
- There is a range of furniture within the room, and most of the walkways around the furniture are 1200mm wide



## Information Room – Facilities Block

- There is an information room at the facilities block, with external access
- The door is 800mm wide with a 30mm step and open inwards
- The room's dimensions are 1000mm x 1900mm
- Information is displayed between 800mm and 1600mm high



## Dog Area

- There is a small dog area behind the toilet block
- There is a paved pathway to access
- The gate opens to 1100mm wide, with the latch at 900mm high
- The ground in this area is grass



## Service Points

- There are Service Points at intervals around the site, please check the site map for details
- All of the service points are on concrete settings, with level access from the adjacent roadways
- The paths around the Service Points can be as narrow as 700mm wide
- The water taps are at a maximum of 750mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Waste Points can be found at some of the service points, please check the site map for details



## Motorhome Service Point

- There is one Motorhome Service Point on site, located opposite the toilet block
- The taps are 900mm high



## Information

### Written Information

- A range of leaflets for local attractions are available in the Information Room.
- Please ask at reception if you have difficulty reading third party leaflets and staff will be happy to read these to you upon request

## Customer Care & Support

### Booking Procedures

- If you have any specific requirements for your stay please contact the site directly and they will be happy to discuss your requirements and reserve you the most suitable pitch wherever possible.

### Evacuation

- There is an assembly point with in the car park in the event of an emergency
- Please ask at reception for more details

### Customer Care and Staff Training

- All on site staff have received disability awareness and etiquette training.



## **Public Transport**

- There is a request bus stop, 1 mile from the site with services that go to Glasgow, Fort William, Inverness, Kyle of Lochalsh and Skye. Please note that these services are not frequent
