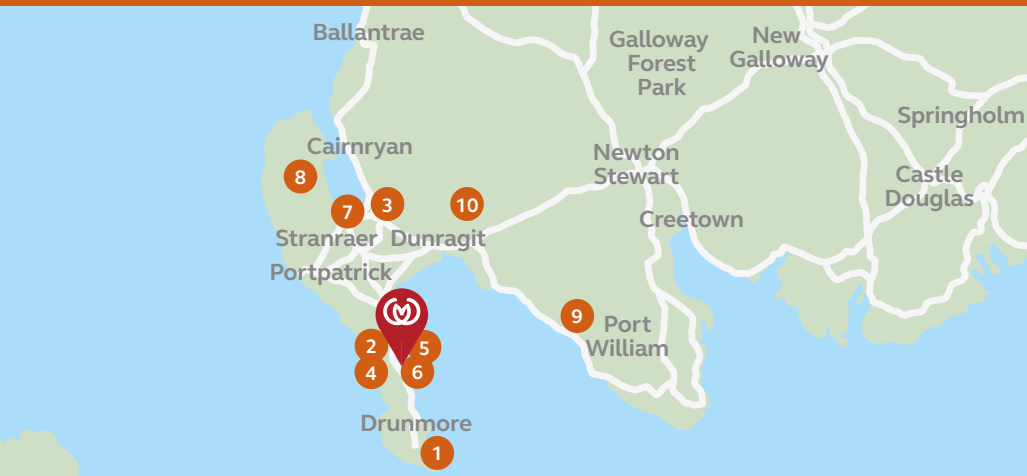

Things to do

1 Mull of Galloway

Scotland's most southerly point, a remote, dramatic cliff headland, an RSPB nature reserve and a lighthouse offering panoramic views.

2 Logan Botanic Gardens

Known as Scotland's Most Exotic Garden, thriving in a subtropical climate created by the Gulf Stream. Showcasing a remarkable collection of rare plants, ferns and palms.

3 Castle Kennedy

A 17th Century ruined tower house within 75 acres of picturesque gardens. Built in 1607 and later gutted by fire, the ivy-clad ruins are a dramatic and romantic centrepiece.

4 Logan Fish Pond Marine Life Centre

UK's oldest natural aquarium, this 200 year-old tidal pool features a natural rock basin where visitors can view and hand-feed Scottish sea life.

5 Watersports

There are a great variety of watersports available on the sea, lochs, canals, rivers and reservoirs.

6 Sea Angling

World-class, year-round, free shore fishing across thousands of miles of coastline, ranging from deep sea lochs to rugged Atlantic coastlines.

7 Ryan Leisure Centre

A comprehensive leisure facility with a swimming pool, a leisure water area with flumes, a health suite with steam room, sauna and spa baths.

8 Titanic Belfast Experience

An iconic, interactive experience located in Belfast's Titanic Quarter, on the exact site where Titanic was constructed. Daily ferries from Cairnryan – 35 minutes from site.

9 Monreith Animal World

A 12 acre countryside park featuring animals, including alpacas, otters, owls, pigs and Shetland ponies – a fun family day out.

10 Glenwhan Gardens

One of the best new gardens, with a Wildflower Walk and views across Luce Bay and the Mull of Galloway.

Walk

The Rhins of Galloway offer plenty to explore, including the Galloway Forest for mountain hikes and woodland walks and the Dark Sky Park.

Enjoy a circular walk to Port Logan and back from the site.

Cycle

There are numerous quiet lanes locally, and the nearest National Cycle Network route is 73: Newton Stewart to Kintyre.

The 7stanes are 7 mountain biking centres spanning the south of Scotland and the route is accessed in The Galloway Forest.
