Things to do

1 Beaulieu

Described as a 'beautiful place' (its name's translation), this village offers a blend of attractions, idyllic countryside with free-roaming ponies and a charming, historic high street.

2 Poole Sea Safari

Thrilling speedboat tours along the Jurassic Coast to Sandbanks, Studland Bay and Old Harry Rocks with guided commentary on local history, geology and wildlife.

3 Stanpit Marsh Nature Reserve

A reserve where the Rivers Avon and Stour meet. A Site of Special Scientific Interest, designated for its diverse habitats and as a sanctuary for wildlife and rare plants.

4 The Needles Landmark

Catch a ferry to the Isle of Wight to see the iconic Needles – chalk sea stacks rising from the sea. Known for their brilliant white colour against colourful sands of Alum Bay.

5 Longdown Activity Farm

A family-friendly attraction focused on interacting with farm animals for children aged 2-10. Daily scheduled activities include bottle-feeding calves and kid goats, handling small animals and tractor rides.

6 The New Forest Centre Museum

A free museum, library, gallery and shop dedicated to the history, wildlife and culture of the New Forest. An interactive, family-friendly introduction to the National Park.

7 Poole

Renowned for Europe's largest natural harbour, stunning golden sand beaches and a vibrant, bustling quayside, combining a rich maritime history with modern tourism.

8 Southampton

A charming waterfront city with centuries of maritime history, including the SeaCity Museum, containing an interactive model of the Titanic.

Walk

There is plenty of good walking near the site in the forest. Information and guide books can be purchased at reception.

Cycle

The New Forest has an extensive cycle way network. Routes start within 500 yards of the site and the nearest National Cycle Network route is 2: Southampton to Exeter.

Bicycle hire is available on site via Appbike, and secure bike storage is available on site for all bicycles.

Site access restrictions:

- ✓ Automatic Number Plate Recognition (Fast check-in)

Connectivity

- ✓ Mobile phone signal, O2 and Vodafone – good. Mobile phone signal may vary depending on network provider
- ✓ TV reception – good. Boosters available on bollards (25 metre aerial coaxial cable may be required)
- ✓ Club Wi-Fi. Premium wifi – *charges apply*. Free wifi to the pitch

Emergency out of hours contact information can be found on the reception door/window, in the information room and on the facility block notice board.

Laundry facilities

- ✓ Machines are token operated only. Tokens are available from reception at £1.25 each. All washing machine cycles are £5, pre-wash is £1.25 and a 15 minute tumble dryer cycle is £1.25

- ✓ Dog walk from site into the New Forest
