Visit

- 1 **Paignton Zoo**
One of England's largest zoos with over 1,200 animals in the beautiful setting of 75 acres of botanical gardens.
- 2 **Trago Mills**
Less than a mile away, offering great shopping, a restaurant and entertainment for kids.
- 3 **Castle Drogo**
A granite castle, standing over 900ft overlooking the River Teign with views of Dartmoor
- 4 **Kent's Cavern Prehistoric Caves**
Prehistoric Cave in UNESCO English Riviera Global Geopark, with a world class history of ancient human activity.

- 5 **RSPB Exe Estuary**
Two areas of coastal grazing marsh. In winter, during floods or around high tide, there are thousands of waterbirds including black-tailed godwits and wigeons.
- 6 **Becky Falls Woodland Park**
Voted Devon's top beauty spot, with woodland walks, waterfalls, animals and a full entertainment programme during school holidays.

7 Dartmoor National Park

The largest and wildest area of open country in Southern England, with over 368 square miles of moorland, forest and woodland.

8 Stover Country Park

Located adjacent to site. Enjoy a pleasant stroll around the lake and spot wildlife. Dog owners must ensure dogs are kept under control and on a lead around the lake. Leaflets about the park, lake and walks can be obtained from the park rangers office.

The nearest National Cycle Network Route is number 28, Okehampton to Newton Abbot.

10 Exeter

One of England's most attractive, vibrant and historically abundant cities, renowned for its diversity of culture, eateries, boutique shops and arts.

11 Torquay

Part of the UNESCO-listed English Riviera, this traditional seaside town is home to a gorgeous sandy beach, international marina and bustling, picturesque harbour.





Visitor's top tips

|| Stover Golf Course offers reduced golfing rates for members staying on site, and has a bar with food available until 5pm (later if events are on).

Teignmouth, Dawlish and Babbacombe are all great nearby beaches.

The Stover Canal is lovely for a stroll around, and we spotted an abundance of wildlife at Stover Country Park.

Newton Abbot is a lovely old market town and is good for fishing.

Take a bike ride on the prom at Torquay, finish with fish & chips on the beach.

The fish & chips from the van that visits site on Fridays were excellent!

We had a wonderful day out on the Dartmouth Steam Railway's Round Robin, which includes a river boat, steam train and bus, visiting Paignton, Dartmouth and Totnes.
