At a Glance



• The site is relatively level throughout

• There is step free access to all facilities

• There is a combined accessible toilet and shower cubicle in the toilet block

Arrival and Reception

Approach Route

- Access onto the site is via a tarmac driveway
- The reception building is on the right hand side of the entrance road
- There is an electric entrance barrier to the site past reception
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

Parking

- There is space in front of the reception building for 2 new arrivals
- There is parking adjacent to reception, with 3 parking bays, one of which is a designated disabled bays
- There is one Late Night Arrival Bay in front of reception with access to electric connection and water

Entrance into Reception

- There is a dropped kerb leading to a paved area to reception
- The door is 800mm wide with a level threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens outwards





Reception

- There is approximately 2650mm x 4350mm turning space, clear of the desk and furniture
- The reception desk is set 950mm above the with a dropped level at 750mm
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop
- There is a selection of items on sale between 70mm and 900mm



Getting around the Site

- The site is generally set relatively level throughout
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac, but do incorporate speed bumps
- The pedestrian paving around the site is either smooth concrete or concrete block

Pitches

- There are 85 pitches on site, all of which are hardstanding and level
- Roll out mats are not provided
- There are a few designated accessible pitches, which are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- The accessible pitches are 22 metres from the toilet block, 85 metres from the information room and 100 metres from reception
- The route from these pitches to the facilities is gently sloping tarmac



Toilets and Changing Facilities

Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Toilet Block

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is set in the middle of the site
- The combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is accessed via an enclosed lobby
- The main door to the lobby is 750mm wide over a chamfered threshold and opens inwards
- The door to the cubicle is 850mm wide, over a level threshold and opens outwards
- The cubicle door is secured by a RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 2750mm x 1900mm
- The WC pan is left hand transfer.
- The shower seat is left hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm, and the shower seat is 500mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 1300mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are 1000mm high
- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1150mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers





Standard Toilets and Washrooms

- There is one toilet and shower block set in the middle of the site
- There is an internal lobby which gives access to all of the toilet facilities and laundry room. There is an external porch which gives access to the Dishwashing Area.
- The main door to the lobby is 750mm wide over a chamfered threshold
- The entrance doors to both the male and female areas are 700mm wide and accessed with a key, the key lock is 1470mm high on each door
- The male toilets have 4 urinals, 6 WC cubicles, 4 privacy cubicles and 6 shower cubicles, one of each is modified with grab rails and outwards opening doors
- The female toilets have 7 WC cubicles, 6 privacy cubicles and 6 shower cubicles, one of each is modified with grab rails and outwards opening doors
- The shower cubicles in the male and female facilities incorporate a 120mm step down into the "wet area"
- Taps in each block incorporate lever controls



Family Room

- The Family Room is accessed via the internal lobby
- The door is 850mm, with a level threshold and opens inwards
- There is a key to access the family room, with the key lock at 1400mm high
- The room has 2800mm x 1950mm clear space, but it does narrow to 1250mm wide clear space by the bath
- There is a half sized bathtub, with a shower above and lever type taps



- There is a lowered WC at 330mm high
- There is a fold down baby change table at 900mm high
- The basin has lever taps

Other Facilities

Dishwashing – Toilet Block

- The dishwashing area is accessed from the external porch
- The door is 800mm wide and can be heavy to open, over a chamfered threshold and opens inwards
- There is 3600mm x 1250mm clear space
- There are sinks at two levels, 3 sinks at 850mm with 600mm knee space below and 1 sink at 750mm high with 500mm knee space below
- Lever taps available



Laundry – Toilet Block

- The laundry room is accessed via the internal lobby
- The door is 850mm wide over a level threshold and opens inwards
- The door opens to a corridor area before the main room
- There is 3800mm x 850mm between the machines and the sinks



- There are 2 front loading washing machines, and 2 front loading tumble dryers however the tumble dryers are stacked on top of each other, with the top tumble dryer's door being 1600mm high
- The coin slots for the machines are 1000mm high
- There are sinks at two levels, 3 sinks at 850mm with 600mm knee space below and 1 sink at 750mm high with 500mm knee space below
- Lever taps fitted



Information Room – Adjacent to Reception

- There is access to the information room via the paved area at reception
- The door opens to 800mm wide over a level threshold and opens inwards
- There is 2200mm x 3000mm clear space within the room
- The information is displayed between 400mm and 1200mm high





Service Points

- There are four Service Points around the site, please check the site map for details
- The service points are on concrete settings with level access from the adjacent roadways
- The paths around the Service Points can be as narrow as 900mm wide
- The water taps are at a maximum of 1050mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Waste Points can be found here too, with taps at 1150mm high



Motorhome Waste Point

- There is one Motorhome Waste Point on site, located close to the toilet block
- The taps are 1250mm above the ground





Information

Written Information

- A range of leaflets for local attractions are available in the Information Room.
- Please ask at reception if you have difficulty reading third party leaflets and staff will be happy to read these to you upon request

Evacuation

- There is an assembly point adjacent to reception in the event of an emergency
- Please ask at reception for more details

• All on site staff have received disability awareness and etiquette training.

Public Transport

- Buses stop at the entrance of the site, and run to Chesterfield
- The nearest train station is in Chesterfield
