Things to do

1 1435 Chesterfield Museum

Set to reopen in 2026 after a major transformation, the new museum will tell the story of Chesterfield whilst celebrating the history of the railway – which reshaped the world.

2 Bolsover Castle

A spectacular 17th Century party palace built on a hilltop as a lavish aristocratic retreat – designed purely for entertainment and pleasure.

3 National Tramway Museum

An open-air museum featuring a reconstructed period street with a working tramway – travel on vintage trams into the countryside.

4 Hardwick Hall

A premier 16th Century Elizabethan prodigy house renowned for its radical, glass-heavy design – Hardwick Hall, more glass than wall.

5 Chesterfield Canal

A waterway linking the River Trent at Chesterfield with West Stockwith passing through countryside and featuring staircase locks. Popular for boating, fishing and walking.

6 Fishing

A mix of tranquil park lakes and historic canal fishing in well-stocked waters. Day permits for the country park can be bought from reception.

7 Creswell Crags

A limestone gorge with caves once inhabited by Neanderthals and early humans during the last Ice Age.

8 Go Ape – Buxton

Brave the heights of the treetop obstacle course with a zipwire, Tarzan Swings, rope ladders and crossings.

9 Chesterfield

A historic market town famous for its Crooked Spire Church, a large open-air market and as a gateway to the Peak District National Park.

10 Bakewell

A charming, historic market town on the banks of the River Wye, famous for the famous Bakewell Pudding.

11 Matlock

A charming, scenic town on the edge of the Peak District National Park, acting as a hub for visitors exploring the surrounding countryside.

Walk

The Trans Pennine Trail is a coast to coast route that passes through the Poolsbrook Country Park.

Outstanding walking, as well as some of England's finest climbing, cycling and caving is available at the Peak District National Park.

Cycle

There are miles of cycle routes from the site through the adjacent Country Park. You can also cycle for miles on the Trans Pennine Trail which passes through the Country Park.
