Things to do

1 The Bowes Museum

A renowned art gallery housed in a magnificent French-style Château surrounded by acres of parkland. It holds a designated collection of European fine and decorative arts.

2 Kiplin Hall and Gardens

A 400 year old Grade 1 listed Jacobean House and museum – the ideal place to experience North Yorkshire country living at its finest.

3 Raby Castle and Deer Park

A 14th Century medieval fortress surrounded by acres of parkland, where red and fallow deer roam. It features a redesigned Walled Garden and adventure playground.

4 The Forbidden Corner

A folly garden located in the Tugill Park Estate, open to the public. The garden is designed as a maze, with tunnels, grottoes and sculptures.

5 Darlington

A busy market town with Quaker heritage, known as the birthplace of the modern railway, where the world's first passenger line opened in 1825.

6 Richmond Castle

One of England's best-preserved and oldest Norman fortresses, situated high on a cliff above the River Swale. Featuring a stone keep, the historic Scolland's Hall and views of the Yorkshire Dales.

7 Barnard Castle

A charming market town renowned for dramatic 12th Century Castle ruins and a thriving, cultural scene. In cobbled streets, Georgian architecture and the Bowes Museum – a gateway to the Dales.

8 Crabtree Fisheries

A private, 2.5 acre estate lake redeveloped into an exclusive, high-spec specimen carp fishery. Set within a secluded, mature, wooded valley with on site facilities.

9 Hawes

This little market town is famous for being England's highest, set 850 feet above sea level. Home to awe-inspiring scenery and unique attractions, including the Wensleydale Creamery.

Walk

The Yorkshire Dales National Park has outstanding scenery and a range of habitats for wildlife and adventure. Perfect for hiking.

Good local walking routes near the site are from Gilling West and Richmond. Details are available from reception.

Cycle

Experienced cyclists can ride locally, with care due to narrow roads.

The nearest National Cycle Network route to site is 52: Walney to Whitby.
