### 9 Local Walks

A walking route starts from the site and takes you to Shripney & back through the nature reserve next door also there are 5 Bognor Heritage Trails available.

Join the South Downs Way which runs for 100 miles between Winchester and Eastbourne, and enjoy the views, wildlife and history.

## 13 Chichester


One of the UK's well-preserved Roman cities, great for shopping and full of history.

#### 14 Arundel

A picturesque town with a historic centre, glorious castle and lots of quirky shops.

### Bognor Regis

A seaside town with not only a popular beach and pier but also steeped in over 200 years of history.





There's a fabulous sandy beach at West Wittering, around a 20-minute drive.

Two downland walks from Slindon and Stoughton are within easy reach. Both are about six miles, and pass good dog-friendly pubs.

Visit to the antique shops of Arundel.

A visit to the Theatre at Chichester in the summer is highly recommended.

In season, a little promenade train goes from Butlins to the Regis Visitor Centre, and the ice cream hut opposite is great!

Bognor Regis hosts a fabulous cinema, The Picturedrome, built in 1885. This is an excellent location for attending events at Goodwood.

The Tangmere Military Aviation Museum is a must-visit for history enthusiasts

The Amberly Museum is a wonderful day out for all the family, and is dog-friendly.

Visit the National Trust's Petworth House in the South Downs, it's beautiful!

The HMS Victory in Portsmouth is the Royal Navy's most famous warship, a great visit for those interested in nautical or wartime history.
