Walk

There is limited walking directly from the site, but Salisbury has several walks and the Test Valley Way from Stockbridge is enjoyable. These are available from the information room.

The Clarendon Way runs from Salisbury to Winchester. It gets its name from Clarendon Park on the eastern edge of Salisbury.

Cycle

There is limited cycling directly from the site, but Salisbury has several cycle trails to help you explore the city.
