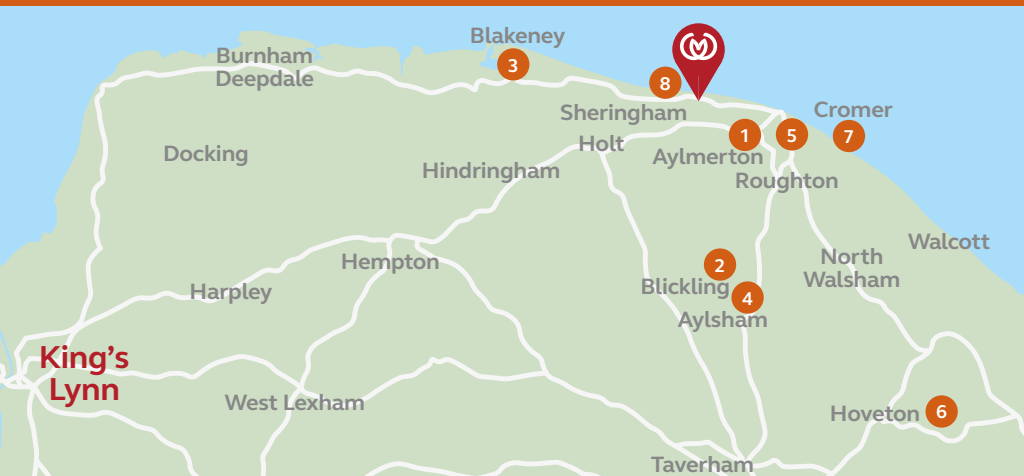

Things to do

1 Felbrigg Hall

One of the finest 17th Century country houses celebrated for its unique blend of Jacobean architecture, fine Georgian interiors and welcoming, lived-in atmosphere.

2 Blickling Estate

The birthplace of Anne Boleyn, this renowned property is famous for its magnificent 17th Century Jacobean Mansion, formal gardens and acres of parkland and woodland.

3 Seal Trips

Take a boat trip to Blakeney Point, home to England's largest grey seal colony. Trips provide close-up views with a guided commentary.

4 Bure Valley Railway

Norfolk's longest narrow gauge railway, operating heritage steam and diesel trains through the countryside between Aylsham and Wroxham.

5 Cromer Pier's Pavilion Theatre

Europe's last remaining full-season end-of-pier variety show, running annually for over 35 years. Offering a traditional, fast-paced mix of comedy, music, dance and specialty acts.

6 BeWILDerwood

A huge woodland adventure park based on a series of children's books by Tom Blofeld. There are treehouses, zipwires, jungle bridges, massive slides, boat trips, marsh walks and great food!

7 Cromer

A beautiful Victorian seaside town renowned for sandy beaches, an iconic pier and famous Cromer crab. With dramatic cliff-top views, a working fishing industry and thriving local community.

8 Sheringham

A vibrant seaside town renowned for its award-winning Blue Flag sandy beach, heritage steam railway and rich fishing heritage.

Walk

The Cromer Lighthouse circular walk is part of the Norfolk Coast Path with a fantastic beach, cliff and heathland walk offering breathtaking views.

Cycle

The Norfolk Coast Cycleway runs through Cromer and other routes are nearby.
