Join the South Downs Way which

runs between Winchester and
Eastbourne through the South
Downs National Park.

8 High Weald Landscape Trail

> A 90 mile route through the AONB which starts at Horsham station and links the villages and historic gardens for which this area is famous.

Follow the Downs Link which runs past the site following an old railway line joining the South to North Downs.

A vibrant market town with excellent shopping, lots of attractions and a rich heritage

This delightful, bohemian seaside city is steeped in vibrant charm and culture.

12 Chichester

Combining the attractions of a thriving urban centre with the rural delights of West Sussex.



I cycled to Cranleigh and could take my bike into a cycle cafe, Maison Du Velo to have a coffee and cake in comfort.

Talk to locals about different walks available as there are more than you think! There's also great local pubs.

Check out the Firebird Brewing Company and Dairy Cafe both at the old brickworks in Rudgwick.

Horsham and Guildford are lovely towns with lots of shops, restaurants and cafes – we also visited the theatre in Horsham which was fantastic!

The National Trust's Petworth House, Leith Hill Place, Polesdon Lacey and Nymans are all well worth a visit.

Don't miss the Bluebell wood in spring, it's beautiful.

The Red Lyon Pub in Slinfold Village was very welcoming and friendly, and served excellent food.

Head to Box Hill in the South Downs for incredible panoramic views.

If you have the time, definitely visit Brighton, Eastbourne and Lewes – they are our favourite places to go!
