EASY | 11 MILES



## ST DAVID'S LLEITHYR MEADOW CYCLE ROUTE

This route takes in part of National Route 4 of the National Cycle Network, which runs from London to St David's. The ride starts at the Club Site and passes through Tretio Common, Caerfachell and The Druids Circle.

### SURFACES

Tarmac.

### TRAFFIC

Light traffic in various sections along the route.

### SUITABILITY FOR YOUNG CHILDREN

Yes, but care should be taken and children should remain under constant supervision.

### HILLS

Steep hill down to Cathedral, and short steep hill back up.

### REFRESHMENTS/FACILITIES

Plenty in St. David's.

### OTHER ROUTES IN THE AREA

National Route 4 continues to Fishguard and Broadhaven. The Brunel Trail is a traffic-free section between Haverfordwest and Neyland.



### DIRECTIONS

- 1 Turn left out of the Club Site and then left again on to National Cycle Network Route 4 following the blue signs.
- 2 Turn left at the T- junction and continue for just over half a mile on the B4583.
- 3 Turn right on to an un-signposted road, passing a field with a standing stone.
- 4 Turn right at the next junction and continue on the road passing through Tretio Common.
- 5 Take great care turning right on to the A487.
- 6 Continue on the A487 for half a mile and then turn left towards Caerfachell.
- 7 At the top of the hill where the road turns left sharply, take the bridleway on the old perimeter track of St. David's airfield.
- 8 The Druids Circle is clearly visible, and is a good place to stop for a picnic. Continue on the perimeter track.
- 9 Turn right rejoining National Route 4 into St. David's and back to the Club Site.

This route has been suggested by Sustrans' Volunteer Rangers. The Caravan Club would always recommend that any children or young people under 18 years should be fully supervised by a responsible adult. Please be aware that using this route is entirely at your own risk. Extreme care should always be taken when cycling on site, remembering that traffic will be moving around the site and to observe speed limits. Particular attention should be paid when going round blind corners or emerging from paths.
