Arrival and Reception

Approach Route

- Access onto the site is via a tarmac driveway
- The reception building is on the left hand side when you enter the site
- The gate from the road is left open at all times but access into the site is controlled via a vehicle barrier controlled by card access.
- The ground is level in this area with hard surfaced paths linking facilities.

Parking

- A new arrival bay is set within a few metres of the Reception building, adjacent to the entrance
- There is a visitor parking area with 6 parking bays, including 1 accessible bay
- There are no Late Night Arrival bays

Entrance into Reception

- There is a ramped approach to reception, the ramp is 5 metres long and in two sections with a level landing between each section. The ramp is 1450mm wide, with handrails to either side.
- There is also a stepped approach available, with 4 steps, and handrails to either side
- The Entrance door is 840mm wide over a level threshold
- The entrance door is not power assisted, and opens outwards
- A call bell is available to summon assistance, this is 1400mm above ground level





Reception

- There is approximately 2900mm x 4400mm turning space, clear of the desk and furniture
- The reception desk is set 1000mm above the floor and incorporates a dropped section at 750mm high
- The desk is not fitted with a hearing loop





Getting around the Site

- The site is generally set relatively level throughout
- Pedestrians share vehicles routes which are well maintained tarmac, but do incorporate speed bumps
- The access road is gently sloping, at a low gradient (1:20)

Pitches

- There are 77 pitches on site, all of which are hardstanding. There are 8 fully serviced pitches on site
- Roll out mats are not provided
- There are no designated accessible pitches, however pitches are allocated according to your needs or preference, so please contact us in advance to discuss your requirements.
- There are 13 pitches within 30 metres of the toilet block which are recommended for people with accessibility needs.


Toilets and Changing Facilities

Accessible Toilets and Bathing Facilities – Toilet Block

- A combined Accessible Toilet and Shower cubicle is located in the Toilet Block which is set in the middle of the site
- The toilet block is accessed via dropped kerbs to a path around the perimeter of the toilet block
- The door is 850mm wide, over a level threshold and opens outwards
- The cubicle door is secured by RADAR key. A key can be borrowed from Reception
- The cubicle's overall dimensions are 2950mm x 2450mm
- The WC pan is right hand transfer.
- The shower seat is left hand transfer
- The toilet seat is 480mm, and the shower seat is 470mm above the floor level
- The clear space to the side of the toilet is 1200mm wide
- The cubicle is fitted with a pull cord alarm, which is tested frequently
- The shower seat and WC Pan are fitted with grab rails to assist transfer
- Shower controls are 1000mm high



- The shower head is fitted on a sliding rail, which is a minimum of 1200mm above floor level
- The basin taps and shower controls are fitted with levers



Standard Toilets and Washrooms

- There is one toilet and shower block set to the middle of the site
- Parking is available next to Toilet Block for one vehicle
- Entrance doors are accessed by a paved area, which is accessed via dropped kerbs
- The entrance doors to the male and female toilets are 840mm wide
- The female area has 7 WC cubicles, 6 Shower cubicles and 4 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- The male area has 4 WC cubicles, 5 Urinals, 6 Shower cubicles and 4 Privacy Washbasin cubicles
- Both of the male and female areas include a modified WC Cubicle, a modified Privacy Washbasin Cubicle and a modified Shower Cubicle for ambulant disabled people
- Taps in each block incorporate lever controls





Toilet Block

Baby and Toddler Room - Toilet Block

- The baby and toddler room is accessed via the path around the perimeter
- The door is 830mm wide and over a level threshold and opens inwards
- The rooms dimensions are 1700mm x 3200mm
- There is a key to access the baby and toddler room, which can be borrowed from reception
- There is a lowered WC at 400mm high and a regular wash basin
- There is a half sized bathtub with a shower over the top, with twist grip taps
- There is a wall mounted, drop down baby changing table at 850mm high





Other Facilities

Dishwashing – Toilet Block

- Level approach via paved area
- The door is 850mm wide over a level threshold and opens inwards
- There is 1400mm x 2600mm manoeuvring space
- There are 4 sinks in counters at 850mm high with 750mm kneespace beneath
- Lever taps available



Laundry – Toilet Block

- Level access via paved area
- The door is 850mm wide over a level threshold and opens inwards
- There is 1900mm x 2600mm manoeuvring space
- There are 2 washing machines, which are front loading with coin slots at 1050mm
- There are 2 tumble dryers, one of which is stacked on top of a washing machine, both are front loading with coin slots at 1050mm
- The higher tumble dryer has a door at 1600mm high
- There are 2 sinks in counters at 850mm high with 750mm kneespace beneath
- Lever taps fitted





Drying Room - Toilet Block

- There is level access from the paved area around the building
- The door is 800mm wide, over a level threshold and opens inwards
- The internal dimensions are 1600mm x 4100mm
- There is only 1200mm space in front of the benches
- There are two slatted benches
- There are coat hooks at 1680mm high





Information Room – Adjacent to Reception

- Access via the ramp and steps used for reception
- The door is 850mm wide over a level threshold and opens inwards
- The room's dimensions are 1900mm x 1900mm
- Information is displayed on a shelves between 500mm and 1600mm high



Children's Playground

- There is a small playground in front of the toilet block
- There is access via a tarmac path
- There is no gate to access the playground
- The play equipment is on safety flooring





Service Points

- There are Service Points at various intervals around the site, please check the site map for details
- All of the service points are on concrete settings
- The paths around the Service Points can be as narrow as 600mm wide
- The water taps are at a maximum of 800mm high, with cross head taps
- Chemical Waste Points can be found here too
- The Chemical Waste taps are 1150mm high



Motorhome Waste Point

- There is one Motorhome Waste Point on site, located close to the toilet block
- The taps are set on a 100mm kerb and are 1150mm high from the kerb





Information

Written Information

- A range of leaflets for local attractions are available in the Information Room.
- Please ask at reception if you have difficulty reading third party leaflets and staff will be happy to read these to you upon request

Evacuation

- There is an assembly point opposite reception in the event of an emergency
- Please ask at reception for more details

Customer Care and Staff Training

• All on site staff have received disability awareness and etiquette training.

Public Transport

- There is a railway station in the local town, 1 mile from the site, with trains to Edinburgh, Aberdeen and beyond
- There are also good bus routes to these cities
