Site Information

Safety on site

Fire point

Please check where your nearest fire point is so you can raise the alarm if you discover a fire, make a note of where the assembly point is and read the fire action notice. Fire extinguishers are provided at the fire points. If fire breaks out, follow the Site Staff's instructions. Keep your children safe by making them aware of the danger of emergency services rushing to the scene. In the event of fire, alarm/warning bells are located at service points and reception.

Dogs and other Pets

You are responsible for your pet's behaviour. Please make sure your pet is under control at all times; dogs must be kept on a secure lead no more than 2 metres long. We know accidents can't always be avoided, but please clean up quickly and use the dog bins provided. Unless you have an assistance dog, dogs aren't allowed in the toilet blocks, laundry rooms or dishwashing areas.

Vehicles and cycles

For the safety and enjoyment of everyone on site, please keep your speed down. The speed limit on all sites is 5mph; that's 1st gear. Pedestrians always have priority over vehicles when crossing site roads. Please expect that young children may move around your vehicle carelessly, because they have little understanding of road risks, and adapt your driving technique to allow for this.

Please make sure you follow one-way systems and there should be no cycling on site during the hours of darkness.

Supervision of children

Parents or guardians are responsible for the safety of children in their care at all times whilst on site.

Security barrier

A card will be issued on arrival.

Visitors

Please ask your visitors to park in visitors' car park and go to reception on arrival. Please meet visitors at reception.

Park gates

You'll need a key for access through the park gates after 5pm. Please ask the site staff as time may change during winter months.

Site facilities

Laundry

Prices: Washing machine £4.00, Tumble dryer £1.00, Rinse & Spin £1.00 per 15min cycle. The washing machine and Tumble dryer are operated by tokens which can be obtained from reception along with a code for the door. Washing sinks are also available. Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on fences.

Toilets and showers

Cleaning times are displayed on the toilet block doors, one toilet is open during cleaning. The accessible toilet and shower facilities require a RADAR key and all blocks require a digital entry code. Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times.

Ball games

Ball games may be played in the country park but not on site.

Pitches

Pitch Care

Please lift awning ground sheets daily. No plastic ground sheets are allowed.

Mobile

Mobile phone reception can be poor on some networks, however there is a pay phone near reception.

Motorhomes

If your pitch is left unoccupied, please leave your motorhome sign on display.

Vacating your pitch

If you wish to stay after 12 noon on your day of departure please ask at Reception before 10am.

Barbecues

These are allowed on site but open fires are not. Please keep barbecues off the grass.


