




A vibrant city with lots of museums, quirky shops a

Visit the local Maker's Market, which runs on every fourth Saturday of the month in Uttoxeter.

A trip to Mercia Marina at Willington is worth a day out. Great dog walks along the canal and nice shops and cafés.

The Dog and Partridge at Marchington hold music events every Sunday night throughout the year.

Walk up the tower of the church in town, it's quite demanding but worth the effort for the fantastic views.

The Dapple Grey Pub was very nice, and the food was excellent.

This is a fantastic location, with the town centre being just a 10-minute walk away, where you'll find lots of shops and eateries.

We really enjoyed visiting the National Trust's Shugborough Estate, Calke Abbey and Dovedale.

Tutbury is lovely, with a pretty, quaint shopping street, boutique stores and a spectacular castle.

The National Memorial Arboretum in Burton-on-Trent is well-worth a visit.
