Visit

West Kirby

West Kirby is a lively town, with many shops, roadside cafés & restaurants. Take a walk along the Victorian promenade and marine lake path with its North Wales coast backdrop.

2 New Brighton

A lovely traditional seaside resort at the mouth of the River Mersey. There you will find UK's longest promenade. There is a sandy beach, amusement arcades, shops and cafés.

3 Parkgate

This is a quaint Victorian village, once an important quayside for boats going to Ireland. Now it boasts 100km of saltmarshes brimming with wildlife.

4 Ferry Cross The Mersey

Drive to Seacombe ferry terminal and take a trip on the Mersey whilst listening to the world famous song sung by Gerry & The Pacemakers. Stop off and venture into Liverpool.

5 Wirral Watersports Centre

Based at West Kirby Marine Lake. Its open for all to launch private craft and runs courses in watersport activities for all the family.

6 Hilbre Island

Go on an adventure to the beautiful Hilbre Island which consists of 3 small islands off the West Kirby coast. See the spectacular views of the Wirral coastline.

Walk & Cycle

Wirral Way

This is a 12 mile long combined walking and cycling route with separate horse riding route which links the site with West Kirby to the west and Parkgate to the East. It is also part of the longer 35 mile Wirral Circular Trail which you can cycle on from the site.

8 Local Walks

Nearest beach is a 5 minutes' walk from the site, turn left out of the site gate. There are lots of other local walks just ask in reception for details

9 National Cycle Network

Route 56 travels through the Wirral from Chester to Liverpool.

10 Liverpool

Explore Liverpool history and culture, both new and old. If you're a Beatles lover then go on an open top bus and visit their old haunts, go on the Old Port Tour, Mersey Tunnel Tour, Cathedral Tours and so much more

11 Port Sunlight

A village built by Lord Leverhulme for his employees in 1888. It boasts wide boulevards lined with charming cottages, all built in an intriguing range of architectural styles. Also take time to visit the Port Sunlight River Park, where you get great views of Liverpool.



12 Country Parks

Wirral is famous for its many country parks and open spaces. Visit Thurstaston Common with views over to North Wales, Royden Park, Eastham Country Park with its views over River Mersey, Birkenhead Park which is one of the first public parks to open in the world and Bidston Hill with its windmill and lighthouse.



Visit the area's Country Parks, including Thurstaston Common, Royden Country Park, Bidston Hill (with its Windmill and inland Lighthouse) and of course Wirral Country Park.

Parkgate has a Victorian seaside promenade with the famous Nicholls Ice Cream Parlour and salt marshes.

West Kirby is a good place to visit, with plenty of cafés, restaurants, clean beaches and lovely small shops.

Visit the Beatles Experience at Liverpool's Albert Docks, you can book online if you want to plan in advance.

The fish and chip van that visits the site on a Tuesday evening is fantastic (5-7pm next to the information room)

A ferry across to Mersey is a must.

The RSPB Burton Mere site is a good day out and is great for bird watching.

The Wirral is well known for its many golf courses, including The Royal Liverpool Golf Club at Hoylake, Caldy, Heswall and Bromborough Golf Club.

The Cottage Loaf Pub is nearby and serves reasonably priced, good food.

Venture out to Chester for the day.
