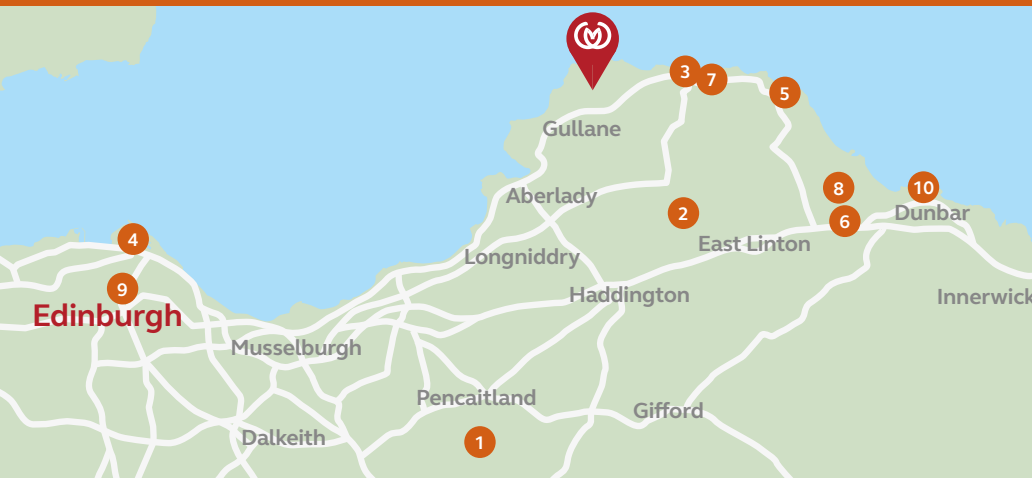

Things to do

- 1 Glenkinchie Distillery**
A single malt Scotch whisky distillery, referred to as 'The Edinburgh Malt'. Celebrated for its light, floral flavour and serving as one of the Four Corners distilleries of Johnnie Walker.
- 2 National Museum of Flight**
One of the UK's best-preserved World War II airfields. Featuring a world-class collection of over aircraft, galleries and the famous supersonic Concorde Experience.
- 3 Scottish Seabird Centre**
A marine conservation centre, famous for its distinctive copper roof shaped like a bird's wing, celebrated for interactive discovery experiences and wildlife boat trips.
- 4 The Royal Yacht Britannia**
A retired floating palace and diplomatic vessel that served the British Royal Family. Launched by Queen Elizabeth II, it sailed over 1,000,000 miles across the globe.
- 5 Seacliff Stables Riding Tours**
Guided horseback riding tours through tranquil countryside, woodlands and along the coast.
- 6 Foxlake Adventures**
An outdoor adrenaline hub famous for being Scotland's first cable wakeboarding park, featuring the UK's first ropes course over water.
- 7 North Berwick Kayak Club**
A friendly paddling club specialising in sea kayaking, white water rafting, river touring and paddleboarding – and supplying all the equipment!
- 8 East Links Family Park**
A farm-themed adventure park with a train safari through animal enclosures, go-karts, a multi-level fortress, trampolines and soft play.
- 9 Edinburgh**
The historic capital of Scotland. One of Europe's most beautiful cities, famous for its distinct architectural split: the labyrinthine Old Town and the elegant, Georgian New Town.
- 10 Dunbar**
A coastal harbour town known affectionately as 'Sunny Dunny', famed for its unusually dry and sunny climate, red sandstone cliffs and proud maritime heritage.

Walk

Easy access from site to the 134 mile John Muir Way: a coast-to-coast route across Scotland's centre.

The walk from Yellowcraig Country Park to North Berwick is around 3 miles each way.

Cycle

There are many cycling routes in the area, including the North Berwick to Edinburgh coastal route.
