This is an open site within the racecourse and only 300m to the sand dunes and beach.

Great Yarmouth is within easy walking distance and has a six acre Pleasure Beach as well as countless traditional seaside attractions and entertainment.

Local visits include Yarmouth Time & Tide Museum, Sea Life Centre and Thrigby Hall Wildlife Gardens. Inland there are the Broads for a leisurely boat cruise in the unspoilt beauty of Britain's largest protected wetland, where you can enjoy the wildlife and see the traditional windmills.

# General site information

## Reception Services

### Mail and messages

Mail and messages are put on the board at Reception.

### Site shop

The information room is open 24 hours. Leaflets are available about the many attractions and places of interest that you can visit during your stay. Gas and Aqua Kem are available from the site office.

### Mobile telephones

All networks can be used on this site.

## Pitches

Please note there are no arrivals on race days.

### Pitch care

Please lift awning ground sheets regularly.

### Motor caravans

If your pitch is left unoccupied, please leave your motor caravan sign on display.

### Vacating your pitch

If you wish to stay after 12 noon on your day of departure, please see the notice at reception.

### Barbecues

These are allowed on site but open fires are not. Please keep barbecues off the grass.

### TV reception

The site now benefits from an excellent digital TV signal. The EHU bollards do not have a TV Socket.

### Electric Hook-up

The costs of electricity are included in your pitch fee, but please help us minimise our effect on the environment by considering your electricity use while on site. Also any saving could help to reduce pitch fees or help towards investments in new sites or redevelopments.

## Site Facilities

Please see the Site map for locations of amenity block.

### Toilets and showers

The toilet block is closed for cleaning at the following times: 10.30am to 12 noon. A toilet is open when the block is being cleaned. There is a baby and toddler bathroom for children under 4 years old. Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times. The disabled toilet and shower facilities are located at the toilet block.

### Laundry

Prices for the use of the laundry facilities are: Washing machine £3.00, Tumble drier 70p/cycle. Washing sinks are also available. Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on the fences.

### Play areas

No ball games or kites on site please. There is access to a toddlers play area. Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times.

## Safety on Site

### Pets

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times on the pitching areas and roads within the site, and clean up after them. There is no dog walk on the site. Dogs can be walked off-site on the sand dunes 5 minutes from the site. Dogs are not allowed anywhere inside the race course grounds.

### Fire point

(to activate alarm/warning) Located at all service points.

### Vehicles and cycles

Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility and therefore they should be supervised at all times, and to ensure that all members of their

party follow the principles of road safety.

Motor vehicles and bicycles on site should, at all times, be used with due regard to the safety and convenience of others and their speed should not exceed walking pace (5mph). No cycling is permitted on site between the hours of dusk and dawn, as determined by the Wardens. Any one-way system signs should be observed by all vehicles and cycles. Foot pedalled cycles, scooters and skateboards can be used, but are not allowed on the paved area around toilet blocks and communal areas and must not be ridden on footpaths. Please note that motorised mobility scooters are allowed on site, but children's motorised scooters or skateboards are not.

### Security barrier

There are security barriers on site.

*Please note:* barbecues and the flying of flags are not permitted on race days and dogs must be kept under close control.

### Visitors

Please ask your visitors to make themselves known at Reception when arriving at the site. If you are expecting visitors after hours, please meet them at Reception. Visitors' cars are not allowed on site on race days.
