Get to know your site

The site has two pitching areas, divided by conifers and flowering cherries, and the overall aspect of the site is of a sloping nature with many of the pitches having distant views of Looe Bay.

With its heated open-air swimming pool, a tennis court, crazy golf and ball game area, there's plenty to do on site.

When you do go out, Looe boasts many fine restaurants and is a place that offers lots of interest including the working fishing harbour (watch the catch come

ashore). You can take the children crabbing to Hannafore Rock Pools where there is a marvellous view of Looe Island and the Eden Project is only 40 minutes' drive away.

If you have walkers in the family, the Cornwall Coastal Path runs right around the peninsula going west, and across the border into Devon travelling east.

Bathing off the coast can be dangerous and particular note must be taken of any local notices.

Reception Services

Mail and messages

Mail and messages are put on the board outside reception.

Site shop

Open at the same times as Reception. The shop sells milk, bread, caravan accessories, newspapers and free-range eggs.

Information Room

Open at the same times as Reception. Leaflets are available about the many attractions and places of interest that you can visit during your stay.

Mobile telephones

Some mobile phones do not work in the area.

Wi-Fi

Wi-fi internet access is available on this site. This can be purchased online.

Pitches

Pitch care

Levelling blocks are required on this site. Please lift awning ground sheets daily.

Motorhomes

If your pitch is left unoccupied, please leave your motorhome sign on display.

Vacating your pitch

If you wish to stay after 12 noon on your day of departure, it is normally not a problem unless the site is fully booked. Please ask at reception.

Barbecues

These are allowed on site but open fires are not. Please keep barbecues off the grass.

TV reception

As part of the Digital Switchover, this region has now had its analogue television signal switched off. In order to watch television on site you will need an Integrated Digital TV (IDTV) or a digital receiver, and you may also need an aerial or satellite dish. Electric Hook-up

The costs of electricity are included in your pitch fee, but please help us minimise our effect on the environment by considering your electricity use while on site. Also any saving could help to reduce pitch fees or help towards investments in new sites or redevelopments.

Site Facilities

Toilets and showers

The toilet blocks are closed for cleaning at the times shown on each block. Disabled toilet and shower facilities are located in each toilet block and a RADAR key is required.

Laundry

Prices for the use of the laundry facilities are: Washing machine £3.00, Tumble drier 70p/cycle, Spin drier 60p/cycle. Washing sinks, Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on the fences.

Recycling facilities

On site and at the Mill Pool car park in Looe and Morrisons supermarket car park in Liskeard.

Play area

Please use designated play area for all games. No ball games are allowed on pitches.

Swimming pool

There is a swimming pool on site. Please read the Swimming Pool Safety Code and ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times. There are no changing facilities. Snack Shack with vending machines is next to the swimming pool. The toilets behind Snack Shack are for swimming pool users only.

Safety on Site

Pets

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times on the pitching areas and roads within the site, and clean up after them. Dogs may be walked on site but not over grass pitches or hardstandings. There is a dog walk on site.

Fire Point

(to activate alarm/warning) Located on service points around the site. The fire assembly point is located in the tennis court.

Vehicles and cycles

Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility and therefore they should be supervised at all times, and to ensure that all members of their party follow the principles of road safety. Motor vehicles and bicycles on site should, at all times, be used with due regard to the safety and convenience of others and their speed should not exceed walking pace (5mph). No cycling is permitted on site between the hours of dusk and dawn, as determined by the Wardens. Any one-way system signs should be observed by all vehicles and cycles. Foot pedalled cycles, scooters and skateboards can be used, but are not allowed on the communal areas and must not be ridden on footpaths. Please note that motorised mobility scooters are allowed on site, but children's motorised scooters or skateboards are not.

Security Barrier

There is a security barrier on site. You will be given a barrier code when you tell the reception staff your pitch number.

Visitors

Please ask your visitors to make themselves known at Reception when arriving at the site. If you are expecting visitors after hours, please meet them at Reception.

The closest is Morrisons in Liskeard, about 7 miles from the site.
