Situated between moor and sea, not far from the ancient village of Modbury, this site with its abundance of wild flowers and birds makes a splendid base from which to explore South Devon.

Reception services

Mail and messages

Mail and messages are put on the board at reception.

Site shop

Open at the same times as reception. The shop sells various essential and non essential items.

Information room

Open at all times. Leaflets are available about the many attractions and places of interest that you can visit during your stay.

Mobile & public telephones

Not all networks are good on this site. There is a public telephone located next to reception. Please note that this phone does not accept incoming calls.

Pitches

Pitch care

Please use breathable ground sheets only, and lift daily.

Motorhomes

If your pitch is left unoccupied, please leave your motorhome sign on display.

Vacating your pitch

If you wish to stay after 12 noon on your day of departure, it is normally not a problem unless the site is fully booked. Please ask the Warden

Barbecues

These are allowed on site but open fires are not. Please keep barbecues off the grass.

TV reception

As part of the Digital Switchover, this region has now had its analogue television signal switched off. In order to watch television on site you will need an Integrated Digital TV (IDTV) or a digital receiver, and you may also need an aerial or satellite dish. Electric hook-up

The costs of electricity are included in your pitch fee, but please help us minimise our effect on the environment by considering your electricity use while on site. Also any saving could help to reduce pitch fees or help towards investments in new sites or redevelopments.

Site facilities

Toilets and showers

The toilet block is closed for cleaning at certain times, please see notices in toilet blocks for times.

The disabled toilet and shower facilities are in the main toilet block by the entrance to the Ladies.

Laundry

Prices for the use of the laundry facilities are: Washing machine £4.00, Tumble drier £1.00, Rinse & Spin £1.00 per 15min cycle. Washing sinks are also available. Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on the fences.

Play areas

There is a play field for ball and field games. Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times.

Recycling facilities

Glass bottles, plastic bottles, tin cans and paper can be placed in the containers at each service point. Other items can be taken to the rear car park of Modbury Health Centre.

Safety on site

Pets

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times on the pitching areas and roads within the site, and please clean up after them. Dogs can be walked on the eastern edge of the site. A dog bin is provided on the dog walk and throughout the site.

Fire point

(to activate alarm/warning) Located at reception and each service point. Assembly point is in the play field.

Vehicles and cycles

Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility and therefore they should be supervised at all times, and to ensure that all members of their party follow the principles of road safety.

Motor vehicles and bicycles on site should, at all times, be used with due regard to the safety and convenience of others and their speed should not exceed walking pace (5mph). No cycling is permitted on site between the hours of dusk and dawn, as determined by the Wardens. Any one-way system signs should be observed by all vehicles and cycles. Foot pedalled cycles, scooters and skateboards can be used, but are not allowed on the paved area around toilet blocks and communal areas and must not be ridden on footpaths. Please note that motorised mobility scooters are allowed on site, but children's motorised scooters or skateboards are not.

Visitors

Please ask your visitors to make themselves known at reception when arriving at the site. If you are expecting visitors after hours, please meet them at reception. There is no car park on site but from 10.00am to 8.00pm, the late night arrivals area can be used.

Power Cables

Kite flying is not allowed on site as there are overhead power cables nearby, but is safe on the grassed children's play field.

There is a small Spar at California Cross, a Co-op in Modbury and a Morrisons and Tesco in Kingsbridge, about 8 miles from the site and 24-hour Tesco at Lee Mill, 8 miles on A38.
