## Get to know Burford

This is an attractive and spacious site with well landscaped pitching areas, opposite the Cotswold Wildlife Park, a popular family attraction in the area. With rhinos, zebras and leopards, children love it and the brass rubbing centre, beautiful gardens and narrow gauge railway make this a good value and special day out.

Burford is a beautiful unspoilt Cotswold village with the warm, honey-coloured stone buildings of the region. On the Oxfordshire edge of the Cotswolds, you are close to the village of Bourton-on-the-Water with its Motor Museum, Model Railway and Pottery; beautiful Bibury and the wool town of Northleach, with its church and eccentric collection of mechanical music. Close by at Filkins is the Cotswold Woollen Weavers with museum, working woollen mill, clothing and soft furnishings.

# General site information

## RECEPTION SERVICES

### Mail and messages

Mail and messages are put on the board at Reception.

### Site Shop

Open at the same times as Reception. The office sells Aqua Kem, Aqua Rinse, Gas, milk, eggs, ice cream, TV cables, walking maps and newspapers and discounted tickets for the Wildlife Park.

### Information Room

Open at the same times as Reception. Leaflets are available about the many attractions and places of interest that you can visit during your stay.

### Mobile & public telephones

Some mobile phones may not work in the area. Public telephone - there is a public telephone located beside the office. Please note that this phone does not accept incoming calls.

## PITCHES

### Pitch care

Awning ground sheets must be lifted daily.

### Motor caravans

If your pitch is left unoccupied, please leave your motor caravan sign on display.

### Vacating your pitch

If you wish to stay after 12 noon on your day of departure, it is normally not a problem unless the site is fully booked. Please enquire at the site office on the morning of your departure.

### Barbecues

These are allowed on site but open fires are not. Please raise barbecues above the ground (the warden can supply blocks to do this).

### TV reception

TV reception is poor. Booster system available through EHU. Digital TV.

### Wi-Fi

Wi-Fi internet access is available on this site. Please ask the Warden for details.

### Electric Hook-up

The cost of electricity is included in your pitch fee, but please help us to minimise our effect on the environment by considering your electricity use while on site. In 2009 The Club's expenditure on electricity was £4 million and any saving can help to reduce pitch fees or invest in new sites or redevelopments.

## SITE FACILITIES

### Toilets and showers

The toilet blocks are closed for cleaning at the following times:

Gents: 10.30am to 11.30am. Ladies: 11.00am to 12 noon.

There is a baby and toddler bathroom for children under 4 years old.

Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times.

The disabled toilet and shower facilities are located in the toilet block (RADAR key required).

### Laundry

Prices for the use of the laundry facilities are:

Washing machine £3.00, Tumble drier 70p/cycle, Spin drier 60p/cycle.

Washing sinks and ironing boards are also available.

Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on the fences.

### Play areas

There is a play area for ball games and a playground with play equipment. Please ensure that children are supervised by an adult at all times.

## SAFETY ON SITE

### Pets

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times on the pitching areas and roads within the site, and clean up after them.

Dogs can be walked on the site behind the car park or beside the wooded area on the west side of the site.



### Fire Point

(to activate alarm/warning) Located at all service points.

Please see the Site map for fire assembly point locations.

### Vehicles and cycles

Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility and therefore they should be supervised at all times, and to ensure that all members of their party follow the principles of road safety.

Motor vehicles and bicycles on site should, at all times, be used with due regard to the safety and convenience of others and their speed should not exceed walking pace (5mph). No cycling is permitted on site between the hours of dusk and dawn, as determined by the Wardens. Any one-way system signs should be observed by all vehicles and cycles. Foot pedalled cycles, scooters and skateboards can be used, but are not allowed on the paved area around toilet blocks and communal areas and must not be ridden on footpaths. Please note that motorised mobility scooters are allowed on site, but children's motorised scooters or skateboards are not.

### Security Barrier

There is a security barrier on site, operated by a card that is given to new arrivals. The barrier card issued to you is for your vehicle only. Please do not use it to let anyone else gain access. If in doubt, please ask the warden.

### Visitors

Please ask your visitors to make themselves known at Reception when arriving at the site. If you are expecting visitors after hours, please meet them at Reception.
