Get to know Wyatts Covert

This site is very conveniently placed not far from both the M25 and M40, but surprisingly green, and screened by trees. London is only eighteen miles away, and you can reach it by train from Denham Green into Marylebone.

If the capital is not for you, visit Windsor for the lovely castle looking almost unreal above the town and valley, and Savill Garden in the Great Park. Also within easy reach are Beaconsfield for the Bekonscot Model Village, Runnymede for its Magna Carta associations, or even Oxford with all the architectural splendours of the colleges.

Don't ignore the Thames - you can enjoy small towns like Marlow and Henley for river trips. For quieter pursuits, visit Cliveden, once the home of the Astors, or West Wycombe Park, both now looked after by the National Trust and for walkers, Denham Country Park and the Grand Union Canal towpath offer hours of easy exercise.

Activities

- **Walking**

There is a nature reserve next to the site. Denham Village has a Country Park. There are also the Nine Stiles circular walk and Wildlife Trust walks.

RECEPTION SERVICES

Mail and messages

Mail and messages are put on the board at Reception.

Site Shop

Open at the same times as Reception. The shop sells toilet chemicals and Gas.

Information Room

Open at all times. Leaflets are available about the many attractions and places of interest that you can visit during your stay.

Mobile & public telephones

All networks can be used on this site. Public telephone - there is a public telephone located next to the site office. Please note that this phone does not accept incoming calls.

PITCHES

Pitch care

Steel awning pegs are required on this site.

Motor caravans

If your pitch is left unoccupied, please leave your motor caravan sign on display.

Vacating your pitch

Due to the restricted access and egress all departures before 12 midday please.

Barbecues

These are allowed on site but open fires are not. Please keep barbecues off the grass.

TV reception

Television reception is fair, best with aerial horizontal.

The best frequencies for TV reception are:

BBC1 - 26; BBC2 - 33; ITV - 23; Channel 4 - 30.

The EHU bollards do not have a TV socket.

Wi-Fi

Wi-fi internet access is available on this site.

Please ask the Warden for details.

Electric Hook-up

The cost of electricity is included in your pitch fee, but please help us to minimise our effect on the environment by considering your electricity use while on site. In 2009 The Club's expenditure on electricity was £4 million and any saving can help to reduce pitch fees or invest in new sites or redevelopments.

Toilets and showers

The toilet blocks are closed for cleaning at the following times:

10.30am - 12 noon

The disabled toilet and shower facilities are located next to Reception.

Laundry

Prices for the use of the laundry facilities are:

Washing sinks and ironing boards are also available.

Please do not hang washing lines between trees or on the fences.

On site for bottles, cans, paper and plastic.



SAFETY ON SITE

Pets

Please keep your dog on a lead at all times on the pitching areas and roads within the site, and clean up after them. Dogs can be walked off-site in the nature reserve 300 yards from the site.

Fire Point

(to activate alarm/warning) Located at the service points at the rear of pitch 46 and opposite pitches 31 & 32 and pitch 14.

Vehicles and cycles

Parents are reminded that children remain their responsibility and therefore they should be supervised at all times, and to ensure that all members of their party follow the principles of road safety.

Motor vehicles and bicycles on site should, at all times, be used with due regard to the safety and convenience of others and their speed should not exceed walking pace (5mph). No cycling is permitted on site between the hours of dusk and dawn, as determined by the Wardens. Any one-way system signs should be observed by all vehicles and cycles. Foot pedalled cycles, scooters and skateboards can be used, but are not allowed on the paved area around toilet blocks and communal areas and must not be ridden on footpaths. Please note that motorised mobility scooters are allowed on site, but children's motorised scooters or skateboards are not.

Security Barrier

There is a security barrier on site operated by a card on entry and exit.

Visitors

Please ask your visitors to make themselves known at Reception when arriving at the site. If you are expecting visitors after hours, please meet them at Reception. All visitors should leave their cars in the visitors' car park near Reception.

OUT AND ABOUT

Supermarkets

The closest is Tesco in Gerards Cross. Sainbury's and Tesco Metro are in Uxbridge, about 5 miles from the site.

Public Transport

There is a train service from Denham Village to London, Marylebone.

There is a bus service 3 times daily Monday to Saturday from the site office to Uxbridge, and on Saturdays to Windsor.
